

Lawrence Kansas October 22nd 1874

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, met at the County Clerk's office, pursuant to adjournment there were present, Commissioners Derkins, Zimmerman and Clark, and the County Clerk, J. B. Smith -

The following proceedings were had

The Board having under consideration, the matter of assessment of certain joint-stock Companies and Banking Companies, J. W. McMillan appeared in obedience to subpoena, and testified concerning the value of certain property of the Lawrence, Gas. Coke, and Coal Company

In the matter of the petition of W. Hadley, for relief in the assessment of the National Bank

Ordered by the Board, that the assessment of the National Bank of Lawrence, be reduced from \$70,000 as returned by the Assessor of the City of Lawrence, to \$50,000, and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to request the Auditor of State to reduce the amount of valuation returned from this County, accordingly

Ordered by the Board that the County Treasurer be requested not to pay any County Orders that may be presented to him, which were issued during R. R. Brooks term of office, unless the said orders are countersigned by the present County Clerk, J. B. Smith

Ordered by the Board, that an appropriation of seven dollars and fifty cents, be made from the general fund of the County, for temporary support of poor in Endora town-ship
