The Board of Commissioners met at the County Clerk's office, pursuant to adjournment there were present Commissioners Deskins, Clark and Zimmerman, and the County Clerk J. B. Smith -

The following proceedings were had -

In the matter of the petition
of A. Fosh and others for
the establishment of a road.

The viewers appointed at the April Session of the Board, having made a report in favor of establishing said road, and also a separate report, in relation to damages claimed and awarded, which reports having this day publicly read, and the matter fully considered, It was Ordered by the Board that the prayer of the petitioners be granted, and the said road as surveyed be established from the place of ending, as prayed for in the petition to the section line dividing sections 19 and 30, as marked upon said report, and plat, as surveyed, and the sum of Forty Dollars each to Peter Ralston and M. B. Brownlee, be, and is hereby allowed as damages in consequence of the establishment of said road -

In the matter of the Petition of
O. Buddelton & John R. Rankin
for the location of a Road.

The same, to be located on the section line between the North East Quarter of Section Nine (9) & the South East Quarter of Section four (4) all in town thirteen (13) of Range Nineteen (19), and the said petition having been
