The petition asking for the location of a road as follows. We the undersigned represent that we are the owners of the following described tracts of land in said County, as follows to wit: S. Fisher owns the west half of the North West quarter of Section ten - J. Mettler owns the east half of said quarter section and J. Shively owns the south West quarter of Section three in township fourteen of Range Eighteen, that your petitioners hereby ask you to lay out a road of the width of thirty feet, between the south west quarter of said Section three, and the North West quarter of Section ten in said Township fourteen of Range Eighteen, as above mentioned, & we, & each of us do hereby dedicate to the County of Douglas the right of way across our respective tracts of land for said road - said road to be on the section line between said quarter sections, and of the width above set forth, and connecting at each end of said road with existing highways - Witness our hands this 6th day of January A.D. 1876-
