the change of a certain road

The petition having been filed in said case, on the 5th day of October A.D. 1874, was this day publicly read, as follows to wit:

We the undersigned, petitioners, householders would respectfully ask your honorable body to change the section line that portion of a road established July 7th 1869 commencing at half section line between the NE^{1/4} and NW^{1/4} of Sec. 24, T. 12, R. 19 and running in a North Westly direction to section line between Sections 16 and 21, and the matter being under consideration by the Board, and there being objection made, and all things pertaining to said change of location fully examined and considered, it is Ordered by the Board that said petition be not granted, and it is hereby rejected -

Upon the request of the Trustee of Clinton township, he was, and is hereby authorized by the Board, to turn over poor persons applying to him for temporary aid, to the Trustee of Marion township, to work on the highways in said Marion township, under direction of said trustee.
