

Lawrence, Kansas January 28th 1875

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met at the office of the County Clerk, pursuant to adjournment, when there were present Commissioners Dickinson, Gimmerson and Clark and the County Clerk T. B. Smith.

The Board instructed C. B. Beck's Exr. to continue to act for L. H. Tuttle, trustee of Palmyra township, in accordance with the request of said Tuttle, during his absence, and have the trustee certify to his acts, in that capacity -

Upon the request of Francis Walters, township Trustee of Leecompton township, and the Board being satisfied that James Stuart, confined in the County jail for the nonpayment of a fine of five dollars and cost, of said on a charge of assault and battery, before Henry Geelan, a Justice of the Peace of Leecompton Township, is unable to pay his fine, and having a family to support, it is therefore Ordered by the Board that the said James Stuart be discharged from custody, subject to payment of costs as provided by law - and that the County Clerk Notify the Co Sheriff, and said Justice of the Peace of this order -

It was ordered by the Board, that a Statement of the receipts and expenditures of the County for the year ending July 13th 1874, be prepared by the Clerk and furnished the printer for publication - and also a statement of the indebtedness of the County, as shown by the Books be published, in accordance with law -
