Lawrence Kansas, January 29th, 1875

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met at the County Clerk's office at 9 o'clock AM, pursuant to adjournment - there were present, Commissioners Deakins, Zimmerman and Clark, and the County Clerk J. B. Smith.

A Committee appointed by, and representing a mass meeting, of the citizens of Lawrence and vicinity, held in the Court room, January 26th, 1875, said Committee consisting of J. R. Rankin and others, presented a report, and Memorial, in reference to a plan for the relief of the destitution now existing throughout the County, which report and Memorial was received.

It was Ordered by the Board, that the County Attorney be, and he is hereby directed to proceed at once to collect the rent due the County, for the property rented to W. D. Carpenter, and known as the Bath House property.
