The Board of Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment, there were present, Commissioners Clark and Zimmerman, and the County Clerk, J. B. Smith - Commissioner Clark acting as Chairman pro-tem -

The Board instructed the County Clerk to notify L. S. Moore the Superintendent of the Co. Asylum, to take Mrs. Meredith, an insane woman, from the County Jail, to the County Asylum, and care for, and provide for her there

Lawrence Kansas April 12th 1875 -

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to Law, at the County Clerk's office. There were present Commissioners Deskins, Clark and Zimmerman and the County Clerk J. B. Smith -

The following proceedings were had -

In the matter of appointment of agent of the County to vote the Stock of the County in the St. Louis Lawrence & Denver Rail Road Co.

It was Ordered by the

Board, that all appointments of proxies to vote the Stock of St. Louis Lawrence and ~~Denver~~ Western Rail Road Company, formerly known as the St. Louis Lawrence & Denver Rail Road, is hereby revoked

Ordered by the Board, that W. Rothrock be allowed to redeem the South East 1/4 of Sec. 13, Town 14, Range 19, from sale for taxes of 1858, upon his paying to the County Treasurer the amount for which the same was sold, with interest at ten per cent per annum, in accordance with provisions of Law

The Board adjourned until tomorrow at 9 A.M.
