And it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board, that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of Douglas County, residing in the vicinity of said proposed road, it is therefore Ordered, that John Walton, John Howard, and Mr Lawrence three disinterested householders of the County, be, and they hereby are appointed viewers and J.C. Darling Surveyor of said road, and that they meet at the place of beginning of said proposed road on the tenth day of June A.D. 1875, and after being duly sworn, proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments, according to law. And it is further Ordered by the Board, that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary order to the Viewers and Surveyor and that said Viewers and Surveyor report their proceedings in the premises to this Board, at its next regular session.

In the matter of the Petition of
B. F. Akers and Others for the
location of a road, as follows

Beginning at a point twenty feet South of the South East corner of Lot Seven (7), in Block (8) Eight of Babcock's addition to the City of Lawrence, thence west to the east line of Section One (1) Township Twelve (12) Range Orin (19)

And now comes B. F. Akers one of the signers of said petition, and files his bond, in the sum of One Hundred dollars, as provided by law, with J. C. Leonard and Paul R. Brooks sureties, conditioned for the payment of the costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, or the proceedings in pursuance thereof be not finally confirmed and established; which bond is accepted and approved, And it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board, that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of Douglas County, residing in the vicinity of said proposed road, it is therefore Ordered, that P. D. Ridenour, John Wilder, and Mr Miller, three disinterested householders of the County, be, and they hereby are appointed Viewers, and J. C. Darling Surveyor of said location of road, and that they meet at the place of beginning of said proposed road, ^{On the 7th day of June 1875} and after being duly sworn proceed to discharge the duties of their several appointments according to law.
