were present, Commissioners Zimmerman, Deskins and
Clark, and the County Clerk J. B. Smith.

The Board made a formal agreement with Holland & Wal-
ter, that said Wheeler should make and furnish the County
with a road map or chart with index for fifty dollars

Ordered by the Board that the seed received from the Central
Relief Committee, to wit, one bushel sweet corn, one bushel of Peas,
and 10 lb Best seeds, be distributed to the township Trustees, for
distribution in the several townships, to those most needing
