The report of the viewers in favor of the establishment of said road was this day publicly read - And said viewers having filed a separate report, in writing, of the amounts of compensation and damages which they have assessed to landowners, by reason of the location of said road through their several premises, said report was publicly read - And the Board, being of the opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed, will be of public utility, and of sufficient importance to the public to justify the payment of the sum of Seventy five Dollars, as compensation for land taken of M. B. Brownlee, it being a strip along the east line of the North West quarter of Section 31, town 13, Range 22, and for damage to said Brownlee in consequence of the location of said road, and the further sum of fifteen dollars to Peter Ralston, as compensation of land taken & damage to said Ralston in consequence of the location of said road four rods across the south line, at the southeast corner of the North West
