

quarter of Section 30, Town 13, Range 20; out of the County Treasury it is Ordered that the County Clerk draw an Order on the County Treasurer, in favor of said Claimants, for the amount of Compensation and damages so awarded to them, respectively; That the several reports of the viewers, with the survey and plat of said road be recorded, and that said road be established a public highway, from the south end, or place ending as described in the petition, to a point on the line of said survey, four rods north of the south line of the North West quarter of Section thirty four thirteen, Range twenty, being the land owned by Peter Ralston -

It is further Ordered that the Clerk issue, in the name of the Board, an order to the Trustees of the township through which any part of said road is located and established, directing them to cause said road to be opened according to Law - said road to be 60 feet in width, and all on the west of the half section line dividing sections 30 and as far south as said road follows on said half section line

Ordered by the Board, that the Clerk notify the Chairman of the State Central Relief Committee, that Geo. W. Goss Esq has been appointed by the board, agent for the County to receive and distribute any and all aid sent to Douglas County -
