

In the matter of Contract

Commissioner Clark moved, that, inasmuch as Commissioner DesKines thought the matter not properly settled when action was last had, in regard to awarding the Contract to Dr Newman, that the vote awarding said Contract be now reconsidered, which motion prevailed, and the vote was reconsidered, when on motion, the matter of letting the Contract for Medical Attendance, and Medicine, for the County Asylum, and As Jail, ~~was~~ for the ensuing year, was postponed until April 22nd 1875 at nine o'clock A.M.

D. D. Benjamin ^{one} of the signers of said petition and files his bond in the sum of Two Hundred ^{Dollars}, as provided by law, with J. L. Jones as Surety, conditioned for the payment of the costs and expenses accruing upon said application, in case the prayer of the petition be not granted, or the proceedings in pursuance thereof are not finally confirmed and established, which bond is accepted and approved - And it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board, that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed road, it is Ordered that C. W. Cady, A. Fisher, and A. Douglas be, and they hereby appoint viewers
