The Board of Commissioners met at the County Clerk's office pursuant to call of the Chairman ^{in special session} there were present Commissioners Deskins - Zimmerman and Clark, and the County Clerk J. B. Smith by W. R. Dutton Deputy

In the matter of letting the Contract
for furnishing medicine and Medical
Attendance for poor at C. Asylum
and prisoners at Co Jail for ensuing year

The former vote having been reconsidered April 17th 1875, and by resolution made the special order for this hour, it was taken up, and considered, when Commissioner L. J. Zimmerman made a motion, "That be being the bid of Dr. Albert Newman be the lowest and best for the County, submitted, it be accepted, and be awarded the Contract, for the ensuing year from first day of May ad 1875, and the motion being second was put, and upon the yeas and nays being demanded and had, Commissioners Zimmerman and Clark voted Aye, and Deskins voted No, and as a majority having voted for the motion, it prevailed, and the Contract was ordered awarded to Dr. Albert Newman, in conformity with his bid, and the Clerk was instructed to prepare articles of Contract for the Chairman of the Board, and Dr. Newman to sign -
