Goss be, and he hereby is appointed as agent for the County, to purchase the seed contemplated in the aforesaid Memorial, and sell for seed, at or below cost to such persons as are ~~unable~~ to pay for the same, and where persons are destitute, and unable to pay, to take their obligation.

The Board adjourned until tomorrow, at 7 1/2 O'clock Am.

Goss as agent of the County, is hereby authorized to draw the same from the County Treasury, in such sums as may be necessary, and he shall be required to render an account to the Board, of all his proceedings in the premises, and return to the Court Clerk, all notes taken from parties to whom he may sell any of the seed herein provided for, on time.
