

Lawrence Kansas, July 14th 1878

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to adjournment at the County Clerk's office when there were present Commissioners DesKines, Clark and Zimmerman, and the County Clerk, J. B. Smith

In the matter of the Petition
of Justus Howell et al, for
the vacation of part of a County Road

The viewers appointed at the April Session, as appears on page 396 of this record, having made their reports in favor of vacating said road as asked for in said petition, and said report having been this day publicly read, and there being no objection made thereto, and it appearing that the law has been fully complied with, in the matter, it is Ordered, that the prayer of the petitioners be granted, and the report of the Viewers and Surveyor accepted, and the road is hereby vacated as prayed for - Ordered further, that the County Clerk record the said reports in the Road Record, and issue in the name of the Board, Notice to the Township Trustee, in the township where said vacation is made -

In the matter of the Petition
of John Dean et al - for the
establishment of a County Road, as shown on page 396 this record.

The Viewers having made their report in favor of the location of a County Road as prayed for, and said report having been publicly read, and it appearing that the law has been fully complied with, and the Board being of the opinion that said road will be of public utility, and benefit, they therefore accept the reports of the viewers and Surveyor, and allow the sum ~~the sum~~ of twenty Dollars as compensation for land taken to John Fenoughty, and it is hereby Ordered that said road be established in accordance with the report of the Viewers ^{and} Surveyor, and it is further Ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board, the necessary order to the proper officers, for the opening of said Road according to law -
