The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met at the County Clerk's office pursuant to adjournment. There were present Commissioners Deskins and Zimmerman, and the County Clerk J. B. Smith.

The following proceedings were had-

By appearing by the Record of Mortgages, in the office of Register of Deeds, that certain persons having mortgages there recorded, not cancelled or transferred, have failed to list the same for taxation according law, and public notice having been given to all such persons by publication in the daily and weekly papers in this County, several persons appeared and listed such mortgages, or explained why they should not be assessed - and the same noted on the margin of the "Abstract of Mortgages", in this office.
