This instrument made, this 16th day of July AD 1875, between the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, in the State of Kansas, in behalf of said County, party of the first part, and Nelson Cobb, William W. Merison and Saml. A. Riggs, Attorneys at Law, parties of the second part, Witnesseth, That the party of the first part employs the parties of the second part, as Attorneys and Counsellors to defend said County in an action pending against it in the Circuit Court of the United States, in which Moses Taylor is plaintiff and said County is defendant, and also to prosecute in the Circuit Courts of the United States, and in the Supreme Court of
