

agree to fulfill the same to the best of their ability -
 And the parties of the second part further agree that in
 any sum which they may receive as a percentage under
 this agreement shall operate as satisfaction to that extent
 of any claim which the parties of the second part may
 be entitled to against said County for fees and services
 in recovering said judgment; but this shall not be
 held to affect any rights which John Hutchings or George
 J. Barker may have in the lawyers fees for recovering said
 judgment; nor shall this contract be held in any
 way as continuing the contract heretofore entered into be-
 tween the party of the first part, and said Cobb, ^{and} Nevins
 or parties of the second part for the recovery of said judgment,
 or as defining, ascertaining, limiting or affecting the rights of
 the parties thereto, or either of them, or of said Hutchings
 or Barker thereunder - except as hereinbefore specifically provided -
