Lawrence Kansas July 27th 1878

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met at the County Clerk's office pursuant to adjournment, when there were present Commissioners Deskins and Zimmerman and the County Clerk, J. B. Smith.

In the matter of the Petition of Ann Mansfield et al, for the location of a County Road. To Commence at the South West corner of the North East quarter of Section W- 24 in Township 12, of Range 19, east - which point is the South West corner of the farm of Martin Adams, in Wakarusa township, in said County, and intersecting the Highway at that point - Thence running East on the South boundary line of said quarter section to a point forty (40) feet east of the east boundary line of the right of way of the Midland Rail Road - Thence running South, and as near as practicable, parallel with the east boundary line of the Right of Way of the Midland Railroad to, and intersecting the Northern Boundary line of the City of Lawrence, in said County, at or as near as practicable to the Northern terminus of Indiana Street, a public street, of said City of Lawrence - Said Road to be forty (40) feet in width, and that portion of said Road, running East and West to have for its Southern boundary line, the Southern boundary line of said quarter section of land above described. And that portion of said road running North and South to have for its Western boundary line, as near as practicable, the Eastern boundary line of the right of way of said Midland Rail road -

The Bond of Ann Mansfield, Martin Adams and Russell A. Forte, having been filed, as security for the costs and expenses incurred by the survey of said proposed road, as is required by law. The Board finding that said petition is signed by at least 12 householders of Douglas County, residing in the vicinity of said proposed Road, Ordered that F. H. Kennedy, Joseph H.
