

file his bond conditioned for the payment of the costs, and expenses accruing on the survey of said proposed location of Road, provided the proceeding had therein be not confirmed and ^{the Road} established, as prayed for to wit: beginning on the west line of Section 6 Town 12, Range 16 about 4 rods south of the Southwest corner of the North west quarter of said Section 6, thence South along the west lines of Sections 6, 7 and 18 to a point where the west line of said Section 18, is intersected by the California Road; that public convenience requires said road to be laid out for public travel, And the Board of County Commissioners being satisfied that said petition was signed by at least 12 householders of said County, residing in the vicinity of said proposed location of road, Ordered, that, W.S. Winters, C. LaBue, and C.F. Deskins, as Viewers and J.C. Darling Surveyor, be, and they are hereby appointed Viewers and Surveyor, for said proposed road, and that they meet at the place of beginning thereof, on the 20th day of September AD 1875, and after being duly sworn, proceed to discharge the duties of their several appointments, and report their proceedings to the Board at its next regular session - And it was further Ordered, that the County Clerk notify the said Viewers and Surveyor, of this Order -

In the Matter of the Petition }

establishment of a County Road, as follows, Commencing at
the North East Corner of the North East quarter of Section
6, Town 13, Range 21, thence running South on section
line three quarters of a mile, to the line dividing the South
east quarter of said Section 6, and there terminate -

Bond in the sum of Two hundred Dollars, Conditioned
for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing in
the survey of said proposed road, provided the pro-
ceedings therein be not confirmed, and the road es-
tablished as prayed for.

fied that said petition is signed by at least 12 free-
holders of Douglas County residing in the vicinity of
the proposed road, Ordered, that A. Douglas, C. Duley,
and W. L. Tuttle, three disinterested householders of said
County as viewers, and J. C. Darling Surveyor, be, and
