

Lawrence Kansas, July 31st 1875

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met, pursuant to adjournment, at the County Clerk's office, when there were present Commissioners Clark, Deskines, and Zimmerman, and the County Clerk, T. B. Smith

On motion of Commissioner Zimmerman, the following motion was unanimously adopted - "Resolved, that the County Attorney is Ordered, to at once bring suit against James Blood, W. S. Beach, and Paul R. Bonds and their Sureties for any and all deficiencies which may be found against them in the report of W. J. Sinclair, ex Robt. Young, investigating Committee"

Upon the request of R. G. Elliott, the Board ^{gave} him time to endeavor to explain the deficiency report against him by the investigating Committee

The Board had under consideration the subject of the appeal of members of School District W. 81, from the action of the County Superintendent of Pub. Inst. ^{in charge of said district}, and after hearing the statement of the Supt. and also of persons aggrieved by the action of the Supt., on motion, the Board sustained the appeal,

The Board adjourned until nine o'clock A. M. August Ninth 1875
