

Lawrence Kansas August 11th 1875

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to adjournment, there were present Commissioners Deskins, and Zimmerman and the County Clerk, J. B. Smith

The Board continued the correction of assessment of the personal property, upon evidence in relation to interest of certain parties in mortgages as shown by the Books and testimony taken

It was Ordered by the Board, that the County Clerk, request the State Auditor to return the copy of Abstract of Railroad Assessment, forwarded him by the County Clerk, for the purpose of correcting errors discovered in the assessors returns of the same -

The Board adjourned until tomorrow at 9 o'clock A. M.
