The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met at the County Clerk's office, pursuant to adjournment, there were present Commissioners Zimmerman and Deskins, and the County Clerk J.B. Smith

The Board appointed Joel S. White, and Amos Coffin, to assist the Probate Judge to examine and count the funds in the hands of the County Treasurer for the 3^d quarter 1875 -

The Board issued legal notice to the Sheriff to serve on the agents, or accounting officers of Kansas Pacific Railway Co, the St Louis Lawrence & Western Railroad Company, the Denver & Lawrence & Galveston Railroad Company, and the Kansas Midland Railroad Co. to appear before the Board on the 16th day of August 1875, and show cause why the returns for assessment and taxation of their respective roads should not be corrected and increased

Notices by postal card, were sent by mail to sundry persons throughout the County, to appear, and show cause why they should not be assessed with mortgages appearing on the records against them not cancelled.

The Board adjourned until 9 O'clock A.M. tomorrow
