

Lawrence Kansas August 16th 1875

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met at the County Clerk's office, in Special Session, at the call of the Chairman, upon the request of two members of the Board - There were present Commissioners Deskines, and Gimmsman and the County Clerk J. B. Smith

The following proceedings were had -

The matter of Considering the Assessment of the Railroad property in this County, having been set for this time, the Board proceeded to examine the same in The notices heretofore issued to the Sheriff to serve on the several Railroad Companies, being returned endorsed properly served on the agent, or accounting ^{Attorney} of the Kansas Pacific Railway Company - The Kansas Midland Railroad Company, the St. Louis Lawrence & Western Railroad Company, and the Bear-
-enworth Lawrence & Galveston Railroad Company, and the Attorney for the several Companies named above, (except the L. L. & G. Rail Road Co.) appeared before the Board -

The Board acting upon the opinion of the County Attorney in the matter, fall back upon the action of the Assessors and sustained the assessments as made, and correction by the Assessors, which correction was approved by the Board

Ordered, by the Board, that the Treasurer be instructed to borrow for the use of the General Fund of the County One, to three thousand dollars, or as much as may be necessary not to exceed \$3000. at a rate of interest not to exceed 12% and for not longer time than sixty days from Sept 1st 1875

The Board adjourned until tomorrow at 9 O'clock A. M.
