

Lawrence Kansas, August 20th 1875.

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met, at the County Clerk's office pursuant to adjournment, there were present Commissioners Deskins and Zimmermann and the County Clerk, J. B. Smith.

The Board Ordered, that the Assessment of G. W. E. Griffith, on his personal property be increased $\$23,225^{56}$ on account of Mortgages appearing against him, the records, and gave the said Griffith personal notice of said increase of his assessment and Ordered the County Clerk to enter the same upon the tax Roll for A.D. 1875.

The Board also Ordered that assessment of the Personal property of W. W. Cockins for 1875 be increased $\$1,763^{20}$ on account of Mortgages which appear of record in his favor, and gave the said W. W. Cockins personal notice of the same, and Ordered the County Clerk to charge the same upon the tax roll of 1875.

Summons was issued to the Sheriff of Douglas County to serve on M. Benas Secretary of the Douglas County Loan and Savings Association, to appear forthwith, and answer as to amount of Capital Stock, and list of stock holders, of said association. The Sheriff returned the summons endorsed, served.

M. Benas, ^(Jury) and Jos. E. Riggs, ^{Att.} appeared for the above named Association, and M. Benas was sworn, and examined by the Board in regard to the property, and interests of said Corporation, and under the instruction of his Attorney refused to answer certain questions put to him by the Board, when the case was postponed until August 25th 1875, for further action.

The H. Rudiger, Secretary of the Lawrence Building and Savings Association, appeared, and this case was postponed until August 24th 1875 at ten O'clock A.M.

Summons was issued to the Sheriff of Douglas County to serve on the Douglas County Loan and Savings Association to appear, on the 25th day of August 1875, at 10 O'clock A.M., at the office of the County Clerk, to take deposition in regard to the Capital Stock, and personal property of
