The Board of Commissioners met at the County Clerk's office, pursuant to adjournment, there were present Commissioners Deekins, and Zimmerman, and the County Clerk, J. B. Smith -

It was Ordered by the Board, that an appropriation of \$75⁰⁰ be and it is hereby made from the General fund of the County, in favor of W. W. Verison, Co. Atty, to enable him to procure depositions, for use in suits pending in Douglas County, in the United States Circuit Court -

The Board had under consideration the matter of increasing the personal property ^{assessment} of M. Hartman of Wakarusa township, who having been cited to show cause why the returns of the Assessor, should not be increased, and the said M. Hartman appearing and refused to answer questions propounded by the Board. Alex Marks, was sworn and testified concerning the property, and interests of the said Hartman, and upon the evidence, the Board ordered that said returns be increased in the sum of \$4000, on account of a certain Mortgage held by said M. Hartman, and not listed by him, and personal notice was given to said Hartman, of said increase.
