Lawrence Kansas, August 26th 1875

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met at the office of the County Clerk, pursuant to adjournment. There were present Commissioners Finmerman and Deskins, and the County Clerk J. B. Smith.

The Board had under consideration, the increase of the assessments returns of the personal property of the North Lawrence Railroad, and Building and Savings Association, and notice having been served on said Corporation, to appear by its proper officers, and furnish the Board with the amount of its Capital Stock, and value of the same, and the Board find that said Association was organized January 1st 1871 and that its Capital Stock consisted of \$20,000, divided into 400 Shares of \$500 each, and that by Article 4th of its Constitution, each stockholder is required to pay the sum of two dollars per share, per month on each share held by him, and the Board do further find, and the Board do further find that on the 1st of March 1875, there had been sold 138 Shares of said Capital Stock, and said Corporation having been organized for 50 months, said 138 Shares, at two dollars per month each, would produce the sum of \$13,800. as the taxable value of the Capital Stock of said Corporation on March 1st 1875. and the Board do assess the said Corporation, for taxation for the year A.D. 1875, with said amount of \$13,800. on its Capital Stock, and direct the County Clerk to charge the same upon the tax duplicate.
