The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to adjournment - there were present Commissioners Deskines, Clark, and Zimmerman, and the County Clerk J. B. Smith

The following proceedings were had - Commissioner Deskines, offered the following written Resolution which was seconded by Commissioner Zimmerman to get it before the Board, for action - "Resolved, that we levy ten mills to pay interest on Railroad Bonds," (Signed) John Deskines Chairman - Commissioner Deskines demanded the vote be taken by ayes and nays - Whereupon the Roll was called, by the Clerk, which resulted as follows - Commissioners Deskines, Clark and Zimmerman voted No, and none voting in the affirmative, and so the Resolution was not adopted -

The following sums were levied by the Board, on the recommendation of the Respective township Trustees for Township tax, for defraying general township expenses, for the Current year, To wit: On all taxable property in Wakarusa township, One mill on the dollar

On all taxable property in Leecompton township, one mill on the dollar

On all taxable property in Clinton township two mills on the dollar

On all taxable property in Marion township, one mill
