Crippen, as Cashier of said Bank, that he make out, and deliver to the County Clerk the Statement required of the Officers of all Banks, by Sections 27^(and) 28, of Chap 107, Laws of Kansas - Genl. Statutes - The further examination of the matter was postponed until Monday Sept 13, 1875, at 9 O'clock A.M., to be continued before the County Clerk at which time the Statement above required, must be filed with the Clerk
