The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, met at the County Clerk's office pursuant to adjournment. There were present, Commissioners Grimsman, Clark, and Deskins, and the County Clerk J. B. Smith.

It appearing there was no levy made for road purposes, at the time for making such levy, Therefore it is Ordered by the Board, that a levy of three mills on the dollar is hereby levied on all the taxable property in the County? outside the incorporated cities

The St Louis Life Insurance Company appeared by J. S. Wilson agent, and filed a decree of the 4th Judicial Court, sitting in and for Douglas County Kans.

Ordered by the Board, that the County Attorney at once take such steps as may be necessary for the collection of the taxes due from the Lawrence Land & Water Power Company, by filing claim in Bankruptcy Court where proceedings are now pending against said L. L. & Waterpower Co., Also said Atty. is directed to file claim for taxes due from the Leavenworth, Lawrence & Galveston Railroad Company; in the United States Circuit Court, where proceedings are now pending for the foreclosure and sale of said Railroad on Mortgage Bonds
