The Board being informed that the property of Lawrence Land and Water power Company has not been listed for taxation for AD 1875; it is Ordered that the property of said Company be assessed for said year at \$16,000 - provided the said Company agrees to said assessment & in said amount; Otherwise the County Clerk is directed to take evidence and assess the same as provided by law - Ordered that the County Clerk notify the President of said Company, of this Order
