The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a certain road: Beginning ^{at the corner stone} at the South east corner of the north east quarter of Section nine township twelve range eighteen; thence ^{west} on the half section line or as near there as practicable, ^{at a distance of one mile to the corner stone} at the South west corner of the north west quarter of Section nine township twelve range eighteen; And whereas Francis Walters one of the petitioners for said road having filed his bond in the sum one hundred dollars payable to the state of Kansas for the use of Douglas county Conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved and it appearing that said petition was signed by at least twelve householders of Douglas County and that notice of said presentation of the petition has been given as provided by law; it is therefore ordered that J. C. Vincent, William Brass and John Hawk, three disinterested householders of the County, be and they are hereby appointed viewers and J. C. Darling Surveyor for said road and that they meet at the place of beginning as designated in said petition on the Twenty ninth day of February A. D. 1876 and after being duly sworn to discharge the duties of their several appointments according to law; And it is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary orders to the viewers and
