The petitioners having made application for the vacation of so much of a county road as lies between the quarter corner on the South of Section twenty-five (25) Township eleven (11) range seven (17) east and the Kansas River on said section, and whereas G. W. Morris, John M. Shiff and William Glenn, petitioners, having filed their bond for the sum of fifty dollars to the State of Kansas for the use of Douglas County for the payment of all costs and expenses in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond has been accepted and approved; and it appearing that said petition was signed by at least twelve householders of Douglas county and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given as required by law it is therefore Ordered, that James Davidson, Wm. H. Christian and Mark Mighane three disinterested householders, of Douglas county, be and are hereby appointed viewers and J. C. Darling Surveyor in the case of said application for vacation of road and that they meet at the place of beginning as designated in said petition on Second day of March A.D. 1876 and after being duly sworn to discharge the duties of their several appointments according to law; and it is further Ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary orders to the viewers and Surveyor.
