

Lawrence, Douglas County Kansas January 21st A.D. 1876.

The Board of Commissioners met in the County Clerk's office pursuant to adjournment. There were present Pochler, Destines and Clark and T. B. Smith County Clerk.

The following business was transacted. A remonstrance filed January 15th A.D. 1876 by T. S. Oliver and D. Martin against the viewers appointed to view a certain road petitioned for by Francis Walter & others was duly considered and passed without any action being taken in regard thereto.

The matter of repairing a bridge over Coon Creek in Leecompton Township on the South line of Sec. 34th Town, 11. Range 18. it was ordered by the Board of Commissioners to appropriate a sum not to exceed one hundred dollars for the repairing of said bridge, payable on the completion of the work. Mr. Francis Walter, Trustee of Leecompton Township was authorized to superintend said repairs.

The matter of contracting with a suitable person to superintend the Poor Asylum for one year from March 1st A.D. 1876. was under consideration pending which the further consideration of the subject was postponed until to-morrow.

A proposition was received from L. F. Laun to purchase from the county tax certificates of Blocks 25, 26, 27, 37, 38, 39 and 40 in "Old Palmyra" which was referred to Commissioner S. S. Clark with instructions to make the best terms of sale possible. Claims against the county were considered and allowed as follows
