

In the matter of Petition
of Edwin Alder & Others

For the location of a County road beginning at the S.W. corner of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section twenty three (23) Township fourteen (14) Range (19) thence north one mile upon said section line or as near as practicable, to intersect with a road running East & West in Douglas County Kansas: And whereas Edwin Alder the principal petitioner has filed a bond unto the state of Kansas for the use of Douglas County conditioned for the payment of all the expenses & cost of the survey and view of said proposed road provided the prayer of the petitioners should not be granted; Now therefore the Board of Commissioners

Order that F. C. Tomberlin; S. R. Deshines; Wm Reeder be appointed viewers and T. C. Darling Surveyor of said proposed road, and that they meet at the place of beginning on and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of their several appointments according to law. 28th day of September 1876
Ordered further that the County Clerk notify the viewers and surveyor of this order of the Board.

In the matter of Petition
of W. D. Martin & Others
for the Location of road

The petitioners having made application for the location of a road Commencing at the south west corner of the north west quarter of section three (3) in township fifteen (15) Range twenty (20) running due east two (2) miles to the center of section one (1) Township fifteen (15) Range twenty (20) And whereas W. D. Martin the principal petitioner has filed a bond unto the state of Kansas for the use of Douglas County which has been approved by the Commissioners conditioned for the payment of all the costs and expense of viewing surveying and locating said proposed road provided the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, and it further appearing that said petition for said road was signed by at least twelve householders of Douglas County and that said petition had fulfilled all the requirements of the law: Therefore it was
Ordered by the Board L. H. Tuttle; S. C. Marshall and Wm Plaskett be appointed viewers and T. C. Darling Surveyor. said viewers being disinterested householders of Douglas county; and that they meet at the place of beginning as set forth in said petition on the 11th day June 1876 and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of their several appointments according to law. And it is further ordered that County Clerk issue the necessary orders to the viewers and Surveyor.
