

In the matter of Petition
of Samuel Kretzinger and
Others for the establishment
of a road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road beginning at the N. W. Corner of the N. W. 1/4 of Section fifteen (15) Township fourteen (14) Range twenty one (21) thence running due south or as near as practicable, four and a half (4 1/2) miles to join the Thelberville road. Said proposed road runs on a section line between sections 15 and 16 = 21 and 22 = 27 and 28 + 33 + 34 in Township fourteen Range 21 and to the quarter corner between section 3 and 4 Township 15, range 21. It appearing from an agreement on file in the clerk's office that the land owners along the line of said proposed road had signed a grant for said road fully meeting the requirements of Sec. 3, Chapter 108 of the Session Laws of 1874 the Board ordered the establishment of said road dispensing with the appointment of viewers & surveyor. And the County Clerk is hereby instructed to note the location of said road upon the road records in his office and to issue the necessary orders for the establishing and opening the said road. Provided that the Commissioners reserve the right of granting permission to certain land owners along the line of said road to erect and maintain gates for three years.

In the matter of Petition
of G. W. Morris and others
for the vacation of certain roads.

The viewers appointed at the January Session of the Board of Commissioners as shown on page 500 of this Record having made their report in favor of vacating said road as asked for in said petition, and said report having been this day publicly read, and there being no objection made thereto, and it appearing that the law has been fully complied with is

Ordered that the prayer of the petitioners be granted and the report of the viewers and surveyor accepted, and the road is hereby vacated as prayed for. And it is further ordered that the County clerk record ~~the~~ said report in the Road Record and issue in the name of the Board notice to the Township Trustee of said township of the vacation of said road.

The Committee appointed to investigate the accounts of S. L. Moore late Superintendent of Poor farm requested that they have power to examine said accounts and books from March 1st 1874 to March 1st 1876 and the Board ordered that their authority be so extended and Commission so changed as to include dates as recited above. Board adjourned until tomorrow morning 9-0 clock A. M. Attest
