The petitioners having made application for the survey and location of a proposed road Commencing at the N.W. corner of Section fourteen (14) Township twelve (12) Range Seventeen (17) at the termination of a county road running East and west through Shawnee County; thence east or near as may be to secure an easy grade one half mile more or less until it intersects the ^{state} road as located by a recent survey; And whereas John Brown one of the petitioners for said road has filed his bond unto the State of Kansas for the use of Douglas county in the penal sum of fifty dollars, conditioned for the payment of all the costs and expenses of the view, survey & location of said road in case the prayer of the said petitioners shall not be granted, or in case the proceeding had in pursuance thereof should not be finally confirmed and established, which obligation has been accepted and approved, and it further appearing that said petition was signed by at least twelve householders of Douglas county, it is therefore ordered William Christians, John Hank and M. S. Hunter, three disinterested householders of Douglas Co. be and are hereby appointed viewers and T. C. Darling Surveyor for said road and that they meet on the 22^d day of June 1876 at the place of beginning as designated in said petition and after having been duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge their duties of their several appointments, according to law and it is further Ordered that the County Clerk in the name of the Board issue the necessary orders to the Viewers and Surveyor to proceed to the view and survey of said road.
