Lawrence Douglas County Kansas April 15th A.D. 1876

The Board of Commissioners met in the office of County Clerk pursuant to adjournment. There were present Pochler, Deshires & Clerk and Deputy Clerk B. B. Digg. ^{Ordered that J. L. Moore be required to pay into the Treasury of Douglas County one hundred and fifty dollars and sixty one cents (\$150.61) in settlement of Poor Asylum fees as far as ascertained to date.}

The Poor Asylum investigating Committee made a supplementary report in relation to the management of the Asylum which was received and considered without arriving at any final action.

The Bond of Simpson Hollister Assessor of the City of Lawrence was approved and filed.

Appropriation: Ordered that the sum of seven dollars and seventy six cents \$7.76 be and is hereby appropriated for the purpose of paying taxes of the year 1875 on the property of Mrs. M. A. Eberly in the Town of Eudora To wit Lots 1-3-5-7-9-11-Block 100 Lots 3-5-7-9-Block 101 Lots 1-3-4 Block O. Lots 1-3-5-7-9-11-13-15-17-19-Block 107 Lots 13-5-7-9-15 Block 138.

Ordered That the Co. Clerk be and is hereby instructed to notify the Co. Treasurer to give redemption certificate to Wiley Jones for the taxes of the year 1861 sold on the 28th day of May 1862 on the following land to wit: 20 acres in NW corner of Sec 9, Town 15, Range 20 upon the condition that said Jones paying the amount for said for 10 cent. \$3.59. and 10 per centum from that date:
