To the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas
 Owing to the increased amount of work in my office (County Clerk) in consequence of the law providing for the semi-annual payment of taxes, and other increasing business and duties of the office with each year, for which the salary now paid is inadequate compensation the same having been reduced over fifty per cent. since I first entered the office; and for other considerations satisfactory to myself - and while thanking the members of the Board for their uniform kindness courtesy and assistance in my official relations with them, I herewith tender my resignation as Clerk of Douglas County Kansas, to take effect the first day of ^{May} A.D. 1876 or as soon thereafter as my successor shall be appointed and qualified.
