

To wit. Commencing at the Southwest corner of the South east quarter of Section twenty seven (27) Township Twelve (12) of Range eighteen (18) Douglas Co. Kansas, running thence due east on the section line between sections twenty seven and thirty six (27) & (36) to the Northwest corner of section thirty five, township Twelve (12) Range 18 and that the Deer Creek road as established July 26th 1869 between these two points wherever deviating from the section line be changed so as to run on the section line and that such portions of the road as now runs off of the section line be vacated.

Now whereas the proposed change of location of road is upon a section line and the parties owning the lands on either side the proposed change have agreed thereto in writing as appears from an agreement filed with said petition, and the Commissioners being satisfied that the relocation prayed for is practicable and can be made without unreasonable expense therefore the appointment of viewers and the survey is ordered dispensed with and the change prayed for granted, and the county clerk is hereby instructed to note such change on the road records of his office, Provided that the said principal petitioner J. P. Orwig shall make the change in the road prayed for as good in every respect as that portion of the road thereby vacated to be approved and accepted by the Township Trustee.

In the matter of Boarding Dr. Yarnold's

In the matter of a road petitioned for by Frank Walter & others

The Commissioners having under consideration a petition signed by Frank Walter & others for the location of a road (see page 498 of this record) the report of the viewers appointed January 5th 1876 having been publicly read, and being in favor of granting the prayer of the petitioners and it appearing the requirements of the law in such cases made & provided have been fulfilled, and that said road is demanded for the convenience and utility of the public it is therefore ordered.

Ordered that the prayer of the petitioners be granted and the report of the viewers accepted with the exception of the award of Damages to David Martin which is changed from forty to fifty dollars \$50.00 and that Thomas Oliver be allowed One dollar damages. And it is further Ordered that in accordance with the report of said viewers that the public convenience requires that said road be established at a width of forty feet. And it is further
