Three and running thence east to the North east corner of the North West quarter of Section One - has not been in any way prepared for public travel nor can it be without an expense incompatible with public interest; He therefore respectfully ask that the above described part of said road may be discontinued And now comes T. D. Martin one of the petitioners for said public road and the discontinuance of said roads and files his bond in the sum of one hundred dollars according to law payable to Douglas county conditioned for the payment of all the costs of the view & Survey of said roads provided the proceedings herein be not fully confirmed by the Board of Commissioners.

And the Board being fully satisfied that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders residents of Douglas county and residing within the vicinity of said roads and that the law has been substantially complied with do hereby

Order that S. H. Tuttle S. H. Marshall and J. E. Carpenter be appointed viewers and T. D. Darling Surveyor and that they meet at the place of beginning on August and after being severally sworn that they proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments, <sup>and make due report to them.</sup> And be it hereby further Ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board notice of this Order to the said viewers and Surveyor
