

Order that F. R. Barnum, W<sup>m</sup> Priestly and R. A. Deer be appointed Surveyors and J. C. Location of a road by Edwin Alderson et al Viewers having been appointed on the same the 13th of April 1876 and time of the survey being June 20th 1876 and failed of fulfillment on account of the sickness of parties interested it is hereby ordered that the proceedings had on said 13th of April be renewed and the same viewers & surveyor continued and that they meet at the place of beginning on 29th day of August 1876 and proceed to the discharge of their several appointments and make due report of their proceedings to the next regular meeting of this board.

Ordered that the County Clerk issue order for one hundred dollars upon the Treasurer of Douglas County in favor of Francis Walter for bridge appropriation for LeCompton Township.
