In the matter of the Submission of a proposition to the holders of the L. L. G. Bonds for compromising the same the following action was had:

Whereas the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas have been petitioned to submit to the holders of the bonds and interest Coupons heretofore issued to the Leavenworth Lawrence and Galveston railroad company, on account of subscription by said county to the capital stock of said railroad company, said bonds dated January 1. 1868 and with the owners and holders of judgments against said county for interest on said bonds Coupons and judgments being now outstanding; for the settlement and compromising of the same by issuing new bonds of said county as provided for by an Act to enable the counties of Douglas, Franklin and Anderson to take up and cancel certain outstanding bonds and Coupons, purporting to be bonds and Coupons of said counties, issued to railroad companies, and all judgments recovered thereon, and to issue
