Lawrence Douglas County Kansas October 11th A.D. 1876

The Board met pursuant to adjournment in the Office of the County Clerk. There were present John Deskins & Samuel S. Blake Commissioners and B. F. Diggs Co. Clerk.

Ordered That James E. Watson Treasurer of Douglas County be and he is hereby authorized to borrow not to exceed Five thousand dollars (\$5,000) at a rate of interest not to exceed 12 per cent and for a time not to exceed Sixty days.

On a motion of Hon John Deskins. Hon John C. Watts of Lawrence was appointed County Commissioner to fill the vacancy occasioned by the resignation of Hon Thos. Pochler. Deskins, Blake & Co. Clerk voting for Mr. Watts.

The County Clerk was instructed to notify Hon Watts of his appointment.
