

laws against this Association as agreed upon August 8th 1876 was reconsidered and it was agreed that the assessment of said Association for the year 1875 be reduced to Four thousand eight hundred and fifty seven dollars & 48¢ and the County Clerk was instructed to change the tax roll to that amount and notify the County Treasurer of said action and instruct him to accept the tax on that amount without penalty, less the amount paid by said Association to apply on the tax of said year. The suit now pending against said Association to be withdrawn and each party to pay his own costs.
