 The Board met in the office of the County Clerk pursuant to adjournment, there
 were present. Samuel L. Clark & John Deskins and B. S. Diggs Co. Clerks.
 In the matter of a petition for a
 Road by John Learnahan & others

The viewers appointed July 8th 1876 (See
 page 562 of this Record) to view the road petitioned for by John Learnahan and others
 made up a report which was publicly read, and it appearing that said report
 is in favor of granting the prayer of the petitioners which having been
 duly considered by the Board believe that the said road would be of public
 utility and that the law has been complied with in every respect, do here
 by grant the prayer of the petitioners and order that said road be estab-
 lished and located and also allow as compensation for land taken
 and damages the following amounts

Allice Peabody \$35.00 Samuel Fisher \$25.00 George Ocharle \$5.00
 William Baldwin \$5.00 Joseph Marshall \$5.00 and the said sums are hereby
 appropriated from the General Fund. It is also ordered that the Clerk issue
 in the name of the Board the necessary order for the opening of said road
 according to law. Said road to be established 40 feet in width.
