W. M. Newison County attorney appeared before the Board and asked for an appropriation of \$35.00 to pay expenses of Brief in the case of Bond suits against the County. And it was Ordered that Thirty five dollars be appropriated for that purpose.

The viewers appointed at the July Session (Page 568 of this Record) made report to the Board which was publicly read, and the report being in favor of the location and establishment of said road and there being no objections and it appearing that the law in such cases made and provided had been complied with in every respect it is hereby ordered that the said road be located and established according to the report of said viewers. It is further ordered that said Road be laid at forty feet in width. (40ft) It is further ordered that George Livingston be allowed Five dollars (5d) damages on account of the location of said road. And the County Clerk is ordered to issue the necessary papers for the location and establishment of said road.
