And the Board being satisfied that the said petition is signed by twelve householders residing within the vicinity of said road and that the law has in all respects been complied with the Board do hereby Order that William Christian, Wm Young & J. C. Vincent be appointed viewers and that J. C. Darling Surveyor to view, survey and report upon said road and that they meet at the place of beginning on the 24th day of November A.D. 1876 and after having been duly sworn to faithfully perform the duties of their several appointments proceed to survey and view said, location and location of said road and make due report to the Board at their next regular session. And it is further Ordered that the County Clerk issue the necessary notice to the viewers and Surveyor of this order of the Board.

The appellants appeared before the Board and stated their reasons for the appeal; The Board took the same under consideration and ordered that the Superintendent be sustained and the appeal dismissed.
