

The following resolution was offered by Mr. S. S. Colclark and adopted by a unanimous vote of the Board.

Whereas Joseph McLebellan an insane person has been ejected from the Insane Asylum on the grounds of certain technicalities of law and Whereas we would not pretend to decide the law involved in the case; but as it would ~~serve~~ ^{serve} humanity and the interests of the taxpayers of this county that she be returned to the Asylum Therefore

Resolved by the Board of Commissioners that J. A. Norton Probate Judge be and is hereby requested to waive all technicalities of Law and have her again legally declared insane in order that she may be sent back to the asylum.

In the matter of repairs on Captains bridge and Eudora Bridge
