There were present John Distine and Geo W. Cady the Clerk B. F. Diggins. The resignation of Mr. Clark was read and accepted and John Walton of Palmyra put in nomination. J. W. Distine, Cady & Diggins. Mr. Walton was declared to fill the vacancy occasioned by the resignation of Mr. Clark.
